

BYLAW #1/93

A bylaw to provide for entering into an agreement for the use, operation, and financial responsibilities for the Town of Eston's landfill:

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Snipe Lake #259, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Snipe Lake #259 is hereby authorized to enter an agreement with the Council of the Town of Eston, the terms of which are attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" for the purpose of the use, operation and financial responsibilities of the Town of Eston's landfill site.
2. The Reeve and Administrator of the Rural Municipality of Snipe Lake #259 are hereby authorized to sign and execute an agreement, the terms of which are set out in Exhibit "A" herebefore referred to.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This AGREEMENT made in this 8th day of March ,A.D. 1993

BETWEEN: The Town of Eston of Saskatchewan, hereinafter called the "Town" being the owner and operator of a landfill site located on the SW 1/4 22-25-20-W3

AND

The Rural Municipality of Snipe Lake of Saskatchewan, hereinafter called the "RM", of the second part.

WHEREAS the parties have agreed that the Town shall permit residents of the RM to use the landfill site to dispose of garbage and a portion of the site specically designed for the disposal of chemical cans.

NOW THEREFORE WITNESSETH that in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained the parties herelo agree as follows:

1. The Town does hereby permit the residents of the RM to use the landfill site to dispose of garbage during the normal operating hours as established by the Town.
2. The Town agrees to permit the RM to construct in the southeast corner of the landfill site a confinement area measuring forty feet square for the disposal of chemical cans.
3. The RM agrees to construct and to pay the cost to construct a five foot high chain link fence together with two access gates for the purpose of defining the confinement area for the disposal of chemical cans.
4. The RM agrees to construct and to pay the cost to construct a roadway outside and along the south side of the south fence of the landfill site to provide access to the chemical can disposal site during hours when the landfill site is not normally open.
5. The Town agrees to remove any papers, cardboard or any other debris blown into the chemical can confinement area or against the confinement fence on a regular and ongoing basis so as to ensure the chemical can disposal site is neat and tidy and of respectful appearance. In order to preserve the quality of the chain link fence any debris blown against it would be physically removed rather than burned.
6. The Town agrees to purchase any bait required for the control of rats and on a regular basis and as often as required and reasonably possible the Pest Control Officer of the RM will place the bait in appropriate baiting stations.
7. The RM agrees to provide heavy equipment to assist the Town in excavation and dirt fill as required within the disposal site.
8. The RM agrees to provide gravel for the access road into the landfill site as required.

The Covenants and promises of this agreement approved by each of the respective councils.
