BYLAW NO. 10-2016

A BYLAW TO REQUIRE CRIMINAL RECORD CHECKS WITH NOMINATION FORMS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Snipe Lake No. 259 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. Every candidate for municipal office shall obtain a criminal record check at their own expense.
- 2. The criminal record check must be:
 - a. in the form prescribed by the minister (Form B.1), attached to this bylaw;
 - b. be included with and form part of the nomination form submitted by the candidate for municipal office;
 - c. be within 30 days of the receipt of the nomination form.
