RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF SNIPE LAKE NO. 259

BYLAW NO 07-2012 *The Municipalities Act Section 111 (2) (i)*

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A LIMIT ON CASH COLLECTIONS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Snipe Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a. "Designated officer" shall mean
 - i) the person appointed as the Administrator of the Municipality; or,
 - ii) the person who has been delegated authority to collect and deposit cash receipts belonging to the municipality;
 - b. "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Snipe Lake No. 259.
2. The designated officer shall deposit in the name of the Municipality, in a financial institution designated by Council, all moneys collected and receipted when they have accumulated to the amount of \$200,000.00.
3. At the discretion of the designated officer, deposits may be made more frequently but in any case, not less than once a month nor more than once each day.
4. This bylaw shall ~~come~~ into effect on May 8, 2012.




