BYLAW NO 05-2012 Subsection 8 (1) (i) & 369 (2) (b) *The Municipalities Act*


A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Snipe Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a. "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b. "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Snipe Lake No. 259.
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with the rates contained within the Fire Rates Bylaw which may be revised from time to time.
3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of the bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
4. Bylaw No. 2-90 is hereby repealed.
4. This bylaw shall come into effect on May 8, 2012.
