

Bylaw 2024-01

Civic Addressing Bylaw

The Council of the Town of Eston in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Purpose

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND OTHER BUILDINGS

Civic addresses help emergency response personnel, such as police, fire and ambulance, to locate a home or business quickly. Addresses also assist other parties such as service or delivery companies to locate a property.

- 1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the "Civic Addressing Bylaw."
- 2. A uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings is hereby established and is shown on the tax roll.
- 3. A separate number shall be assigned for each building.
- 4. Each house or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated.
- 5. Notwithstanding section 4 of this bylaw, upon request of the owner of a property situated on a corner, the number assigned may be specific to the flankage.
- 6. Numerals indicating the official number of each house or building, or each front entrance shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
- Anyone found to violate the regulations outlined in this bylaw shall be deemed to have committed an offense and, once convicted, shall be subject to the following consequences: They will be required to pay a fine of \$150, which will be allocated towards the procurement of house numbers.
- 8. This bylaw shall come into effect on the day of its final passing.
- 9. Bylaw No. 77-71 is hereby repealed on the passing of this bylaw 2024-01
