

Duties of Reeve

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF SNIPE LAKE NO. 259

BYLAW NO 08-2012

A BYLAW TO SUPPLEMENT AND/OR LIMIT THE GENERAL DUTIES OF THE REEVE

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Snipe Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a. "Act" shall mean *The Municipalities Act*;
 - b. "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - c. "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality;
 - d. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Snipe Lake No. 259;
 - e. "Reeve" shall mean the person who has been elected to the office of reeve of the municipality;
2. In addition to those duties conferred by the Act, the Reeve may:
 - a. present a motion for consideration by council;
 - b. take part in debate of a motion before council;
 - c. relinquish the chair at any time and for any reason to the deputy reeve;
 - d. suspend any municipal employee, not including the administrator, for cause and subsequent thereto shall report to council at its next meeting the suspension and the reasons for that action to the council, which shall then reinstate or dismiss the suspended employee;
 - e. authorize the removal, without warrant, of any vehicle that, in his or her opinion, is parked or left on a municipal road at a place or in any manner that constitutes a hazard to other users of the road or road allowance or unduly interferes with construction, maintenance or snow removal operations and cause said vehicle to be relocated to a suitable place where it no longer constitutes a hazard or interferes with construction, maintenance or snow removal operations;
 - f. other duties deemed appropriate by council – signing cheques & signing agreements.
3. Notwithstanding the general duties conferred by section 93 of the Act:
 - a. the reeve of the municipality presides when in attendance at the regular and special meetings of council;
 - b. performs any other duty imposed on a reeve by this or any other Act or by bylaw or resolution; and
 - c. the reeve is a member of all council committees or other bodies established by council
4. This bylaw shall come into effect on May 8, 2012.
